



WHEEL & PAINT CLEANER



Wheel & Paint Cleaner dissolves brake dust, embedded iron particles and chemical fallout on wheels and painted body surfaces. When sprayed onto surfaces, Wheel & Paint Cleaner turns red in color indicating the rust and iron particles are dissolving. After 3-5 minutes rinse contaminants away and wash as usual.

Directions:

NOTE: Use in a well ventilated area. Product will turn red when dissolving metal particles. Do not allow product to dry on vehicle in sun.

For Wheels:

1. Wet entire wheel and surrounding area with water.
2. Liberally spray Wheel and Paint Cleaner directly on surface.
3. Allow product to dwell for 3 to 5 minutes. For stubborn contamination, use a soft brush or wash mitt to agitate the surface.
4. Rinse well with water.

For painted body surfaces:

1. Thoroughly wash and rinse surfaces to remove loose dirt and contaminants.
2. Liberally spray Wheel and Paint Cleaner on area to be cleaned.
3. Allow product to dwell for 3 to 5 minutes. For stubborn contamination, use a soft brush or wash mitt to agitate the surface.
4. Wash as usual.

Storage:

Do not store in direct sunlight. Keep container tightly closed and in a cool, dry place. Keep from freezing.

First Aid Measures:

- **EYE CONTACT:** Flush immediately with large amounts of clean water for a minimum of 15 minutes, lifting upper and lower lids occasionally. Do not rub eyes. If any irritation persists, seek medical attention.
- **SKIN CONTACT:** Remove/take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water.
- **INHALATION:** Remove to fresh air, if breathing is difficult, give oxygen.
- **INGESTION:** Do not induce vomiting. If the person is conscious, give two glasses of water to dilute the ingested material. Follow up with several glasses of fruit juice or very dilute vinegar or carbonated soda to neutralize the alkaline material. Small amounts that may have accidentally entered the mouth should be rinsed out thoroughly with water. Seek medical attention immediately.
