Directions:

SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE AND DURING USE. Spray LASER™ on rusted or corroded parts. Allow 2-3 minutes for LASER™ to penetrate. Tapping parts will help accelerate the penetrating action. On extremely corroded parts a second application may be needed.

TO DISPLACE MOISTURE: Make sure all electrical connections are off, disconnected and parts are cool to the touch before spraying engine or equipment. Allow adequate time for spray to dry completely before reconnecting any electrical components.

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. Do NOT induce vomiting.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.
