Directions:

IMPORTANT: KEEP OFF FLOORS OR OTHER SURFACES WHERE SLIPPERINESS CAN BE DANGEROUS.

1. Shake can well before using.
2. Apply SUPER SPRAY SATIN™ to a clean, dry surface with smooth even strokes keeping can moving.
3. No wiping necessary on most surfaces. On leather surfaces and seating areas allow product to penetrate for several minutes before buffing with a clean dry cloth.
4. In tight areas, or if less gloss is desired, apply product to a microfiber cloth or sponge and then wipe evenly over surface.
5. For higher gloss, apply multiple coats.
