Directions:

ALWAYS STORE AND USE FABRI-FOAM™ AT AN AVERAGE TEMPERATURE OF 70°F.

NOTE: TEST SMALL INCONSPICUOUS AREA FOR COMPATIBILITY.

1. Shake well before using.
2. Holding can in an upside-down position, spray area to be cleaned. Let foam sit for 30 seconds.
3. Gently rub area with a clean damp cloth or towel. Use a brush on stubborn dirt or on textured surfaces.
4. Blot with a clean cloth.
5. Vacuum any sand or grit after area has dried.
