Directions:

INTERIORS: Shake container before using. Spray or wipe on vinyl and rubber surfaces.. Allow to dry.

TIRES: Shake container before using. Spray on tire. Allow to dry.

NOTE: Dazzle is designed to provide a slippery finish. Therefore, do not apply to brake or clutch pedals or rubber floor mats.
