Directions:

Shake can well before using.

For New Batteries: Hold can 10-12 inches from area to be treated. Spray LIFE GUARD™ on battery terminals and cables. For best results, spray two thin coats on terminals. Be sure terminals are attached to battery prior to treating.

For Old Batteries: Use Well Worth's KLEENSEEK™ battery cleaner to completely remove any corrosion buildup first. After all surfaces are clean, follow treatment procedure for new batteries.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER: Extremely flammable aerosol. Contains gas under pressure, may explode if heated. May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways. May cause drowsiness or dizziness. Causes skin irritation. Causes eye irritation. Very toxic to aquatic life.

Prevention: Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flame and other ignition sources. Do not pierce or burn, even after use. Avoid breathing dust, mist, vapors, spray. Wash thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Contaminated work clothing must not be allowed out of workplace. Wear protective gloves. Avoid release to environment.

First Aid: IF INHALED: If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, and obtain immediate medical assistance. IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Consult a poison control center or physician immediately. IF SWALLOWED: Ingestion is unlikely to occur. If swallowed do not induce vomiting because of risk of aspiration into the lungs. If aspiration is suspected obtain immediate medical attention. IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting the upper and lower eyelids. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

Storage: Protect from sunlight. Do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C/122°F. Store in well-ventilated place. Keep container tightly closed. Store locked up.

Disposal: Dispose of contents and container in accordance with local, regional, national and international regulations. Keep product from freezing.
